

What do I need to do a Master?

If you wish to do a Master, first you will need to complete a Degree. For this you will have to apply for the validation of your university degree. This is different to the nostrification of your degree. A nostrification can take up to 3 years. Usually, all you need is the documentation of the degree.

How long is a Master?

A Master is usually one year long, that is, 60 credits. However, as it happens with the Degree, you can opt for a reduced registration and do a Master in more than a year.

At the Universidad of Burgos there is only one Master which is two years long, the Master's Degree in Research into the Economics of the Firm.

What Masters can I study at the UBU?

At the moment you have the following options:

- Master's Degree in Advanced Chemistry
- Master's Degree in Food Safety and Biotechnology
- Master's Degree in Research into the Economics of the Firm (Inter-university)
- Master's Degree in Thermodynamic Fluid Engineering (Interuniversity)
- Master's Degree in Research into Thermal Engineering (Interuniversity)
- Master's Degree in Medieval History of Castilla y León (Interuniversity)
- Master's Degree in Secondary, Baccalaureate, Vocational and Foreign Language Education.
